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High Risk Behaviors and Substance Abuse training is a student teaching and initial licensure requirement with the State of Iowa. Students must complete this training before UNI can recommend them for their Iowa Teaching license.

Students must receive 14 out of 20 for successful completion of the assessment. Once taken, the training is good for 5 years.

The College of Education Advising and Teacher Education Success office will review completed training submissions.

Once it is determined a student has successfully completed the training, the CATS office will enter a service indicator code in SIS (the students official record) showing this requirement has been met. Students can view this information in MyUniverse>Student Center>General Information>Service Indicator.
