

University of Northern Iowa to induct students into Teacher Education Program on October 17, 2018.

CEDAR FALLS, Iowa--The University of Northern Iowa College of Education will host its bi-annual Teacher Education Induction Convocation at 4 pm, Wednesday, March 27th, 2019, in the Great Hall of the Gallagher-Bluedorn Performing Arts Center.

Two hundred and seventy five students have satisfied requirements for admission into the UNI Teacher Education Program, and are invited to participate in the formal ceremony, the official induction of students into that field of study.
